Bespoke Workshop Opportunities If your school is preparing a production, or students want to learn about lighting/sound desks, we have 1 hour, half day & full day packages where our tech team come to your school to train students. These can also be facilitated in the Guildhall, so students can experience a working venue. We also work with schools to create bespoke workshop packages, supporting work being delivered at school. These can be combined with a visit to the Guildhall, or facilitated in the classroom. Examples of commissioned workshops include: <i>Environment</i> workshop, featuring junk percussion. <i>The Bear and the Piano</i> creative writing & English session, featuring a history 'bear hunt' and performance by our Guildhall bear!
