

## **Job Title: Assistant Musical Director – Summer Youth Project**

### **Overview:**

The Summer Youth Project at the White Rock Theatre offers young performers aged 8-18 the opportunity to participate in a professional, full-scale musical theatre production. This year's production will be **Addams Family: The Musical**. We are seeking an **Assistant Musical Director** to work alongside the Musical Director and assist in preparing the young cast for the production, ensuring the music and vocal elements are delivered to a high standard.

### **Role Description:**

As the Assistant Musical Director, you will work closely with the Musical Director to support the vocal arrangements and musical rehearsals. You will help lead the young performers through their musical numbers and assist in the preparation for the live performances. You will also provide general support to the Musical Director, including rehearsal management and leading vocal warm ups.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Assist the Musical Director in rehearsing the young cast and helping them prepare their vocal parts.
- Help teach and support young performers with their vocal technique, pitch, harmonies, and stage presence.
- Support the Musical Director with the musical arrangements and adaptations as needed.
- Attend pre-production meetings.
- Support vocal rehearsals during the two-week project period, from 3rd August to 16th August 2025, with specific hours to be discussed at the interview stage.
- Assist the Musical Director with leading vocal warm ups.
- Ensure a supportive and encouraging atmosphere during the rehearsal process.

- Leading vocal warm ups.
- Strong communication and organisational skills.
- Ability to work with young performers and help them reach their vocal potential.
